Mazda to Donate to Recovery Efforts after Record Rains in July 2018

HIROSHIMA, Japan – Mazda Motor Corporation wishes to convey its heartfelt sympathy and concern for all people affected by the recent record rains. We would like to express our sincere condolences to those affected, and pray for a prompt recovery in all affected areas.

As a Hiroshima-based company, Mazda has decided to donate a total of 100 million yen to contribute to a swift recovery from this disaster. Eighty million yen will be allocated to the prefecture of Hiroshima and 20 million yen to the Japanese Red Cross Society.

In addition, Mazda provided approximately 23,000 liters of drinking water in plastic bottles and 1,500 sandbags from its disaster management reserves.

Placing the highest priority on the recovery of the region, Mazda will continue to provide necessities and personnel support in close cooperation with local communities.
