Mazda has decided to suspend operations at the plants described below. This decision was made as a result of expected difficulties regarding parts procurement due to uncertainties surrounding the resumption of cargo loading areas in China and the spread of COVID-19 in Southeast Asia.

The plants concerned will resume operations on Sept. 1, 2021.

Plants affected:	Hiroshima Plant and Hofu Plant
Planned suspension period:	A total of two days (Aug. 30 and Aug. 31).
